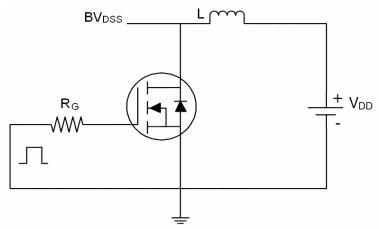




## 1) E<sub>AS</sub> test Circuit



## 2) Gate charge test Circuit




### 3) Switch Time Test Circuit





**Figure 2 Transfer Characteristics** 





Figure 3 Rdson- Drain Current

Figure 4 Rdson-JunctionTemperature




Figure 5 Gate Charge




Figure 6 Source- Drain Diode Forward






Figure 7 Capacitance vs Vds

Figure 9 ID Current Derating vs Junction **Temperature** 






Figure 8 Safe Operation Area



T<sub>J</sub>-Junction Temperature(°C)




Square Wave Pluse Duration(sec)
